Detailed Itinerary:

Day 1 Tue, Oct 7 Depart US - Varies

Today you will depart home and board a flight to Istanbul.

Day 2 Wed, Oct 8 Travel Day

Fly Istanbul to Singapore.

Day 3 Thu, Oct 9 Arrive Singapore 7:30am

Welcome to Singapore! Upon Arrival, greeted by our local tour guide at the airport and transfer to your hotel. You can enjoy your free time at leisure.

Day 4 Fri, Oct 10 Singapore (B, L)

After breakfast, our splendid tour begins. Singapore means 'lion city', in Sanskrit dialect. Visit the Merlion, the symbol of Singapore. Singapore offers a variety compendium of Asian cultures. Explore Chinatown and Little India. After lunch, visit Gardens by the bay - flower dome.

Day 5 Sat, Oct 11 Singapore - Bali (B)

Today you will take a flight to Bali. (Flight included)
Upon clearing Customs and Immigration, you are met by our guide. Then you will go to your hotel for check-in. After that, enjoy some free time at the beach or hotel resort.

Day 6 Sun, Oct 12 Bali (B, D)

This morning you will enjoy the breakfast at the hotel and will have some leisure time to relax. Then, experience an evening of Kechak Dance at a cliff top temple followed by a barbeque seafood dinner under the stars.

In the late afternoon you will be taken to the location of the famous cliff hanging temple at Uluwatu. Perched on the edge of a steep cliff, the temple sits 70 meters above the crashing waves of the Indian Ocean. The temple is inhabited by a large number of monkeys, many of whom can be found roaming the pathways. As the sun sets over the glittering ocean, watch a dramatic Kechak Dance or Ramayana Monkey Chant performance at the temple. Wearing traditional checked cloth around their waists, the male dancers chant in unison while depicting a battle from the Ramayana. After the performance drive to one of the beautiful beaches in Jimbaran for a barbeque seafood dinner in a beach restaurant. Feast on a succulent seafood platter including prawns, grilled fish, squid and clams. Try some 'kangkung', also known as Indonesian water spinach, and add some heat in the form of sambal, the spicy Indonesian sauce.

Day 7 Mon, Oct 13 Bali (B, L)

Today spend a full day discovering the natural beauty and ancient relics of the Balinese midlands.

Meet your guide and driver and then start the day with a visit to Pura Taman Ayun, the 17th century temple of Mengwi, set in a beautiful park with trees and ponds full of lotus blossoms. The large spacious temples and multi-tiered shrines are surrounded by a wide, elegant moat. Continue to Bedugul, a village in the central highlands famous for its stunning beauty and three lakes. Stroll around the traditional market where a myriad of fruits, vegetables, orchids, exotic spices and souvenirs are for sale. At the nearby Lake Bratan, you can photograph the Ulun Danu temple, built on small islands in the serene lake. After lunch in a local restaurant drive southwards to the famous UNESCO Heritage listed rice terraces of Jatiluwih. Trek through this area of green stepped rice fields and hear about the Subak irrigation system that has been preserved by the Balinese farmers for centuries. Return to your hotel via scenic roads.

Day 8 Tue, Oct 14 Bali (B)

Today is a free- day at leisure or Optional Tour.

Enhancing Ubud with Lunch: \$90/person Tirta Empul Temple

Visit the Tirta Empul Temple, built in 960 B.C. during the reign of Warmadewa Dynasty. A temple has been built around natural springs and special bathing pools. The unstoppable water flow is believed to be able to cure any kind of disease. Balinese believe that by bathing in the holy springs, their spirits will be cleansed and their physical illnesses will be cured.

Ubud Market

Set amidst emerald green rice paddies and steep ravines in the stunning central Balinese foothills, Ubud was originally an important source of medicinal herbs and plants. Visit Ubud art market located in the center of the town just opposite the Palace, stroll in the market and through the streets - the only way to really appreciate the special atmosphere one will find here.

Ubud Palace

The Ubud Palace, officially Puri Saren Agung, is a historical building complex situated in Ubud, Gianyar Regency of Bali, Indonesia. The palace was the official residence of the royal family of Ubud. It was on his travels that Rsi Markandya received a divine revelation that in Bali he was to bury five precious metals on a mountain slope where the mother temple of Besakih now stands today.

Day 9 Wed, Oct 15 Fly Bali - Thailand Pattaya (B)

Today you will fly to Bangkok. (Flight included) DPS-DMK

After arrival, drive to scenic Pattaya, a popular vacation spot on the east coast of the Gulf of Thailand whose beaches and entertainments draw thousands of visitors annually. On the way, stop at Gemstone Gallery, Asia's biggest museum for gems and stones!!! Where you can see how traditional Thailand precious items are produced for sale and purchase some as souvenirs for friends and families. Upon arrival, visit the Buddha Mountain (Khao Chi Chan), a famous place as it features a giant sculptural image of Lord Buddha erected on the giant cliff. The remainder of the day is at your leisure to relaxing on the sands or by the pool.

Day 10 Thu, Oct 16 Pattaya to Bangkok (B, L)

Today drive to Bangkok. Your sightseeing in Bangkok begins with a visit to the Bangkok Chinatown District, and the Bangkok's largest Flower Markets Pak Khlong Talat. Afterwards, explore Bangkok's must-sees - The Grand Palace, the landmark that tops Bangkok's must-see list. Head inside the 18th-century walled complex, and stroll around the gold-trimmed pavilions, terraces, shrines and courtyards as you learn how, when and why they were built. Cap your visit with a peek inside the palace's magnificent Temple of the Emerald Buddha (Wat Phra Kaew), home to a 14th-century Buddha statue carved from jade.

Day 11 Fri, Oct 17 Bangkok (B)

Today is a free day for last minute shopping.
